④ **Collective Action**

④ **Trauma-Informed Response**

We recognize the many forms of trauma experienced by both individuals and communities and respond with empathy, compassion, and respect for self-determination.

Descriptors: Empathy, compassion, seeing/hearing/listening, humanity, historical trauma, recognizing experiences of folks of all identities across the lifespan, cultural trauma, self-determination.

④ **Intentional Inclusivity**

We celebrate the experiences of people of all ages and identities and center the needs and voices of marginalized groups in our programs, services, and practices.

Descriptors: Historical trauma, all identities and ages, intersectionality, equality, oppression, celebrating other cultures, centering the experiences of marginalized groups, acceptance that transcends tolerance.

④ **Authentic Connection**

We engage in meaningful relationships that affirm the whole person, honoring our interdependence with each other and our environment.

Descriptors: Relationships we have with individuals and partner agencies, promoting healthy relationships, making connections, encouraging community-building, welcoming the whole person, recognizing and honoring our interdependence with each other and our environment.

④ **Community Accountability**

We call on community members, partners, leaders, and ourselves to respond, repair, and prevent the damage caused by violence.

Descriptors: All of us have a part in responding to violence and supporting survivors; education, prevention, awareness, accountability for offenders, social change.
